Every year on Earth Day, members of l'Association des Acadiens-Métis Souriquois (AAMS) have a tree planting ceremony. In the past, a tree was planted at a local school in either Clare or Argyle. This year the AAMS directorate would like to plant a tree on the beautiful grounds of the Clare Municipal Building on April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2017.

The cost of a young healthy tree is in the \$50.00 to \$75.00 range. Provided the Municipality of Clare can cover its cost, AAMS will handle the actual planting including a Seven Directions Prayer, aboriginal singing, and drumming.
